

## Applying for your Disabled Status Identification Card

British Columbia Ferry Services Inc. (BC Ferries) Disabled Status Identification Cards provide a discounted rate for residents of British Columbia who have a **permanent** disability.

To receive the discounted rate you must present your BC Ferries Disabled Status Identification Card when you arrive at the ferry terminal. Discounts apply to passenger fares only and not to vehicle rates. If you require an escort to travel, your escort will also receive the discounted rate.

A qualifying permanent disability may result in the inability to:

- carry out personal care activities such as preparation, serving and eating of meals, dressing, washing, bathing, personal grooming, etc.
- be mobile without personal assistance
- manage personal affairs without supervision

Passengers requiring the use of an "overheight" vehicle equipped with a wheelchair lift or ramp may travel at the posted "underheight" vehicle (or car) tariff, with or without a Disabled Status Identification Card. Please inform the Ticket Agent of your vehicle's special status.

As discounts cannot be given after you have completed your trip, any discrepancies involving the fare you are charged should be resolved prior to sailing.

The disabled person's rate cannot be combined with promotional offers or with other special fares such as a BC senior's discount.

Disabled Status Identification Cards are valid for 5 years. Please allow 2-3 weeks to process your application.

### **Organized Groups:**

A group of people with disabilities travelling together are not required to apply individually for Disabled Status Identification Cards. An organization for people with physical or mental disabilities may follow this procedure to receive the discounted rate:

- The leader of the group would write a letter on the Association's letterhead, confirming the number of people who will be travelling (including escorts) and date and direction of travel. (A list of the individual's names is not required).
- Present this letter to the Ticket Agent at the terminal when you are purchasing tickets. This will confirm your group's eligibility.
- Photocopy your letter to use on the return trip and for multiple vehicles travelling.

## Disabled Status Identification Card Application

Discounted fares are available for residents of British Columbia who have a permanent disability (this applies to passenger fares only). To receive the discounted fare you must apply for a BC Ferries' Disabled Status Identification Card which you will present to the Ticket Agent when you arrive at the terminal.

A qualifying permanent disability may result in the inability to:

- carry out personal care activities such as preparation, serving and eating of meals, dressing, washing, bathing, personal grooming, etc.
- be mobile without personal assistance
- manage personal affairs without supervision

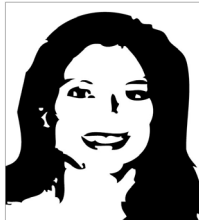

**SECTION 4: PHOTO DETAILS**

BC Ferries requires photographic identification to verify your identity at the ticket booth so we can apply the discount to your fare. This photo will be laminated onto your Disability Status Identification Card and copies of the photograph will not be kept on file by BC Ferries \*. The photograph requirements are as follows:

- Photos must show a full front view of the face with both edges of the face showing clearly. The face and shoulders must be centred in the photo and squared to the camera. Photo size should be 3.5 cm high x 3 cm wide.
- Eyes must be open and clearly visible. Glasses, including tinted ones with prescription, may be worn as long as the eyes are clearly visible. Sunglasses are unacceptable.
- Hats and other head coverings are not permitted except when worn for religious or medical reasons and only if the full facial features are clearly visible.
- Both black and white or colour photos are acceptable. Photocopies will not be accepted.

\*If you do not provide a photo with your DSI Application, please be advised that you will be required to show government issued photo ID along with your DSI card at the terminal in order to receive the discounted fare.
