

Request under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*:

The total number of BC Ferries scheduled sailings and the total number of sailing cancellations due to adverse weather conditions per annum from 2003 through 2019.

Response:

A sailing is any departure from one port to another port. For example, Tsawwassen to Sturdies Bay (Galiano Island), Sturdies Bay to Village Bay (Mayne Island), and Village Bay to Tsawwassen is three sailings.

The table below provides the cancellations of overall scheduled sailings for weather-related reasons:
