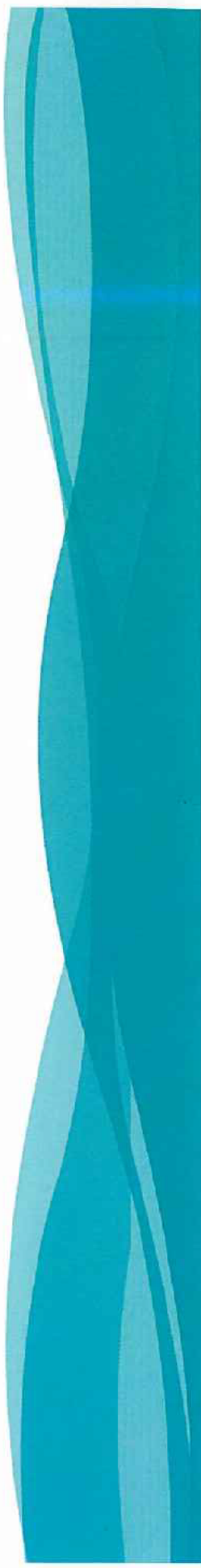

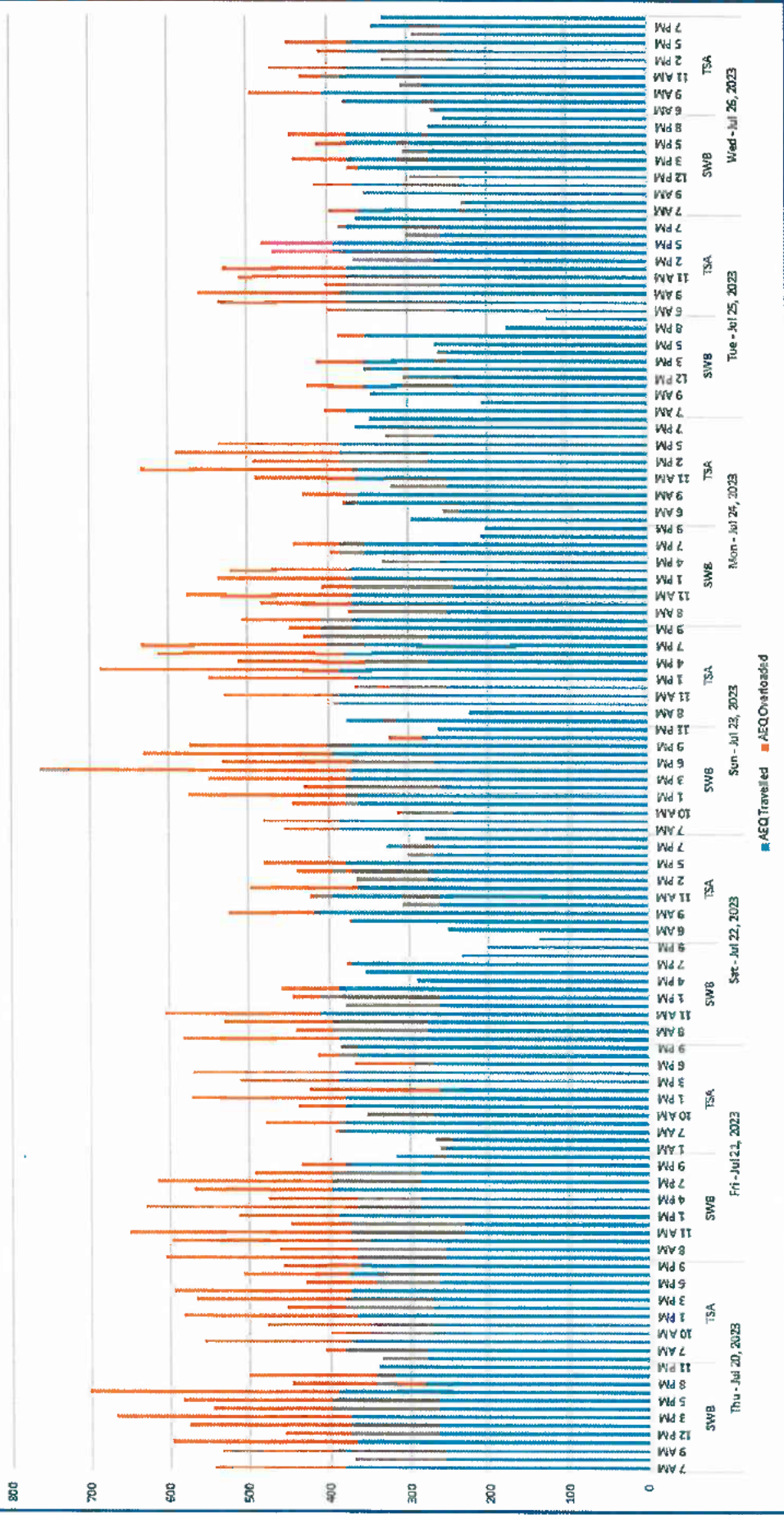

Actual AEQ Travelled and Overloaded by Sailing - Route 1 from July 20 to 26, 2023

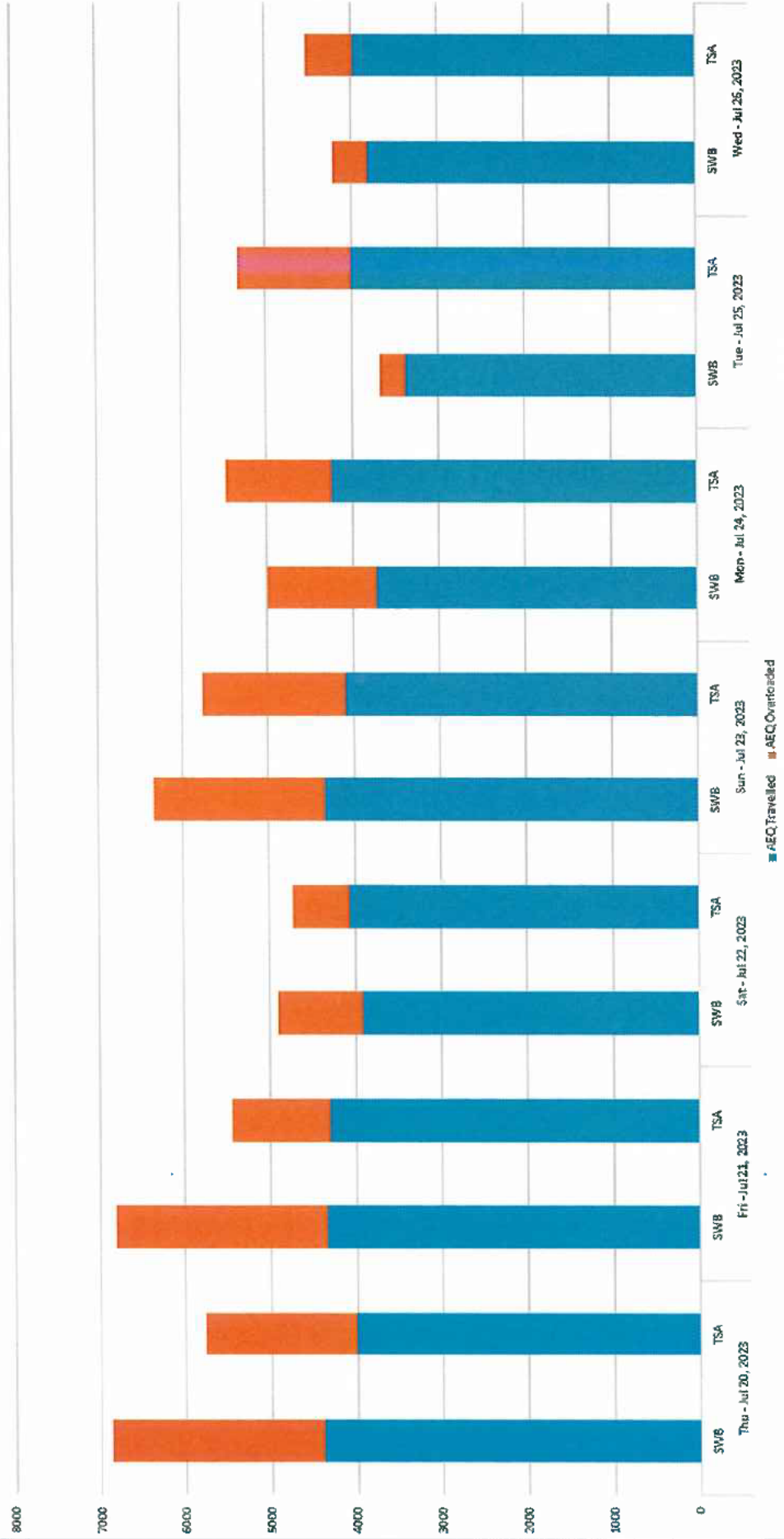

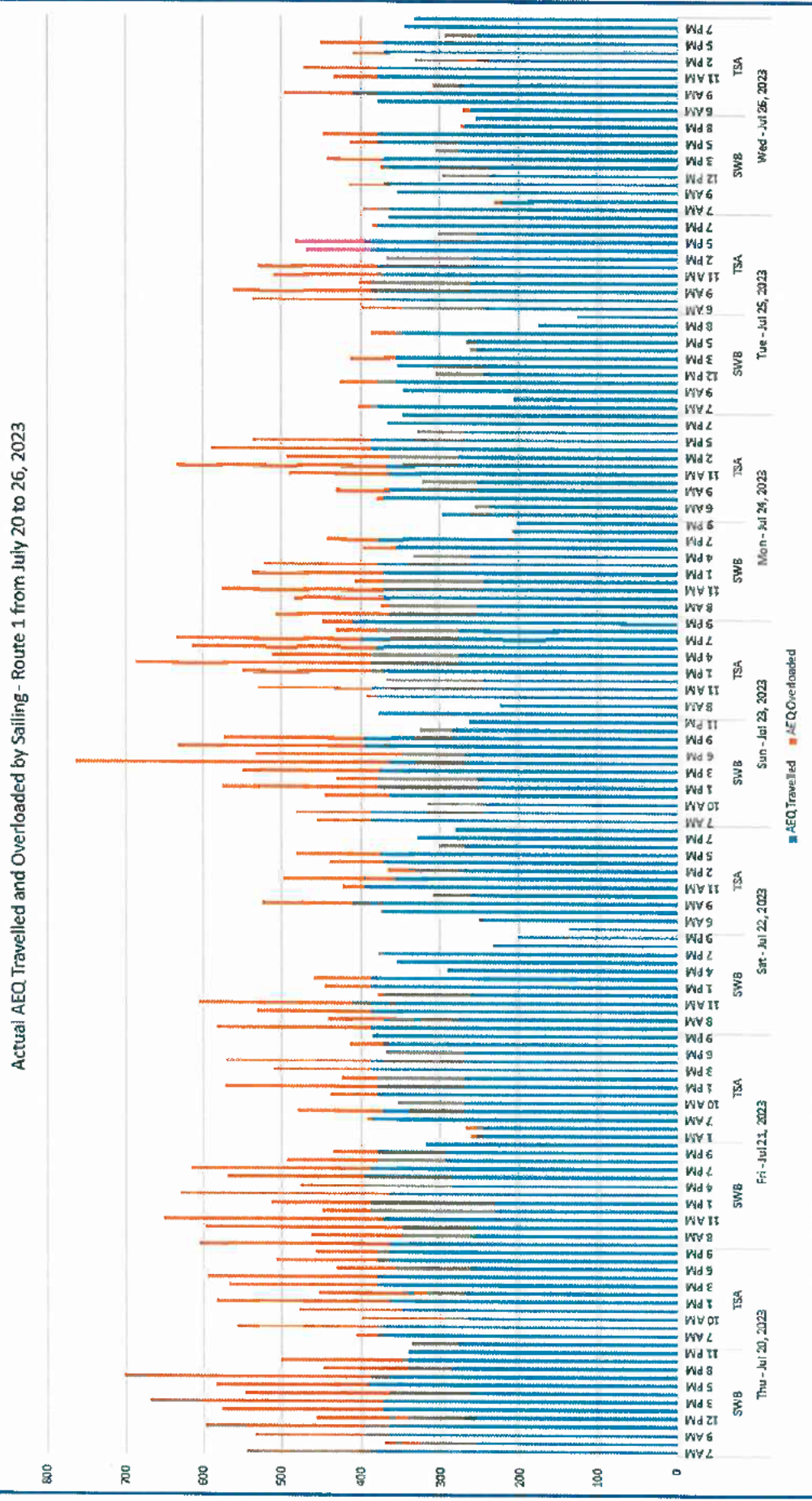

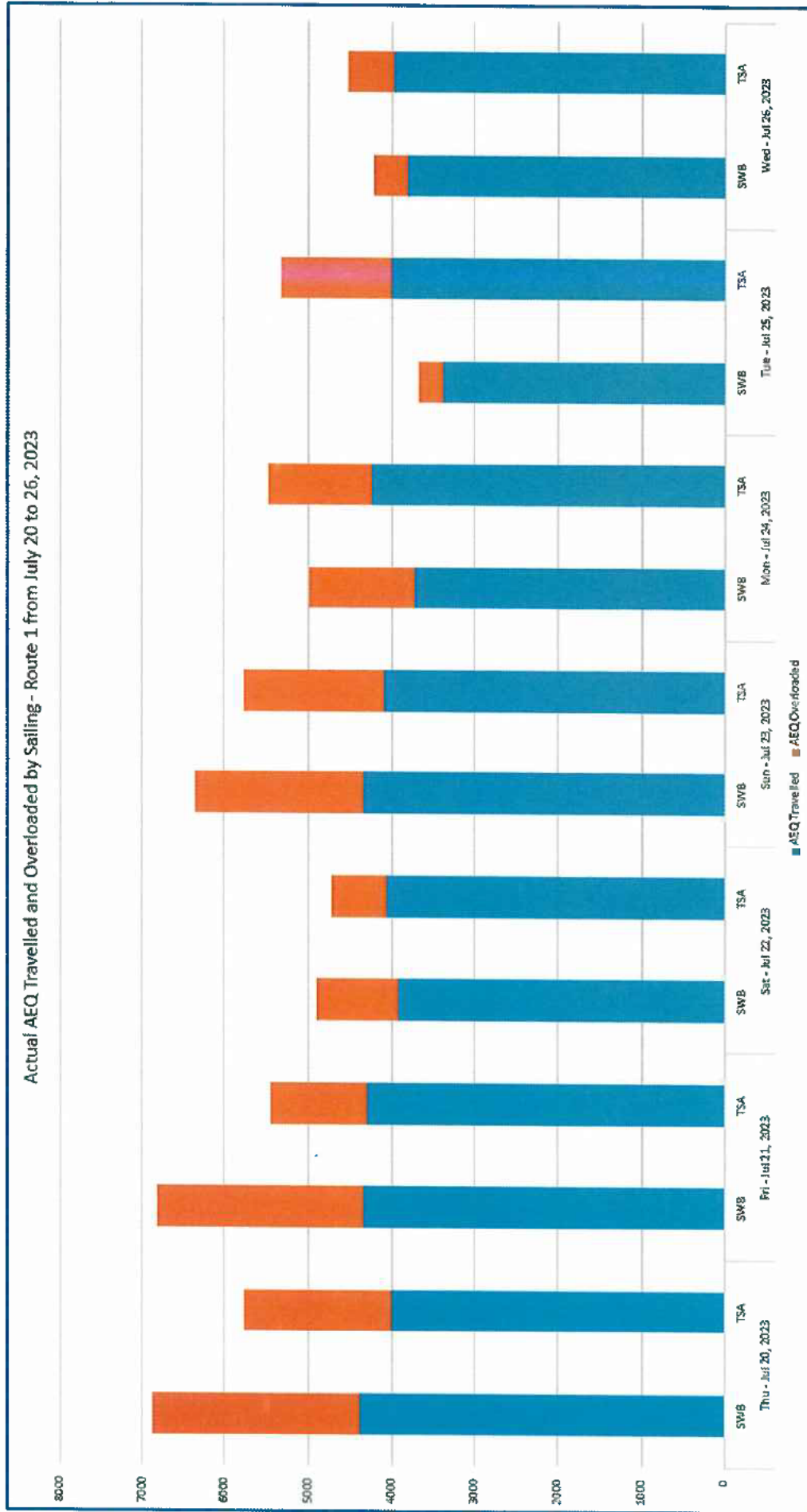
