Re: Request under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*

British Columbia Ferry Services Inc. (BC Ferries) received your request for access to records under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the FOIPP Act) on February 5, 2019. Your request was as follows:

1. *A copy of the submission made by Western Pacific Marine in response to the 2010 Request for Proposal by B.C. Ferries (RFP 12-06-2010) for the provision of Marine Transportation Services between French Creek on Vancouver Island and False Bay on Lasqueti Island. (Note that this request is not for financial disclosure but for the undertakings made by WPM in response to the conditions and stipulations of the RFP.)*
2. *A copy of the contract entered into between B.C. Ferries and Western Pacific Marine with the effective date of April 1, 2012, and correspondence between the parties in respect of the contract.*
3. *A list of respondents to RFP 12-06-2010.*
4. *A copy of the contract between B.C. Ferries and Western Pacific Marine for the provision of walk-on passenger marine transportation service between and among Port McNeill (Vancouver Island), Alert Bay (Cormorant Island) and Sointula (Malcolm Island).*

Further to my letter of April 25, 2019, the third parties had until May 24, 2019 to apply to the Information and Privacy Commissioner for a review of our decision regarding the partial disclosure of records responsive to this request. The third parties did not request a review for records responsive to items two and three of your request. Copies of these records are enclosed. We will write to you separately regarding items one and four.

One of the enclosed records contains information excepted from disclosure under the FOIPP Act. We have withheld a signature pursuant to section 22, as disclosure of this personal information would be an unreasonable invasion of a third party's privacy. An excerpt of the relevant section is attached.

As noted to you previously, you may also find a copy of the contract responsive to item 2 on BC Ferries' freedom of information request tracker under request 17-032 at <https://www.bcferrries.com/about/foi/archive.php?y=2017>.

Thank you for your deposit of \$23.50 for this request, received on February 27, 2019. The final charge for this portion of your request is \$7.70. We have calculated this amount as follows:
